Staff Report: Ms. Graham stated that she and Hawthorne recently met with representatives from Consumers Energy about a proposed demolition and rebuilding of their facility on West Green Street. The time frame for this project is within the next year or two. This property is within the Urban Services District 3.

New Business:

<u>Flag Signage in JPC District</u>: Discussion occurred on current regulations of temporary signage within the JPC District. Hatfield indicated that the City would be reviewing its sign ordinance in the future. The Commission also agreed to review its sign ordinance at an upcoming meeting. The JPC currently follows the fee schedule of the City. Discussion occurred on the legality of placing time constraints on signage.

<u>Island 425 for Meijer Corporation:</u> Hawthorne noted that the Rutland Township Board of Trustees had passed a motion at its meeting on May 14 to send the Island 425 agreement for Meijer to the City

Council for its consideration at an upcoming meeting. Following the City decision, the County, City and Township will convene to discuss next steps. Water would need to be extended from the Dollar Tree store to the Meijer site. Sewer would need to be extended from the Barry County Road Commission to the Meijer site.

Public Comments: Mr. Jones asked questions about the 425 agreement with Meijer.

It was moved by Wiswell and seconded by Hawthorne that the meeting be adjourned. All members present voting yes; motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:00 p.m.
